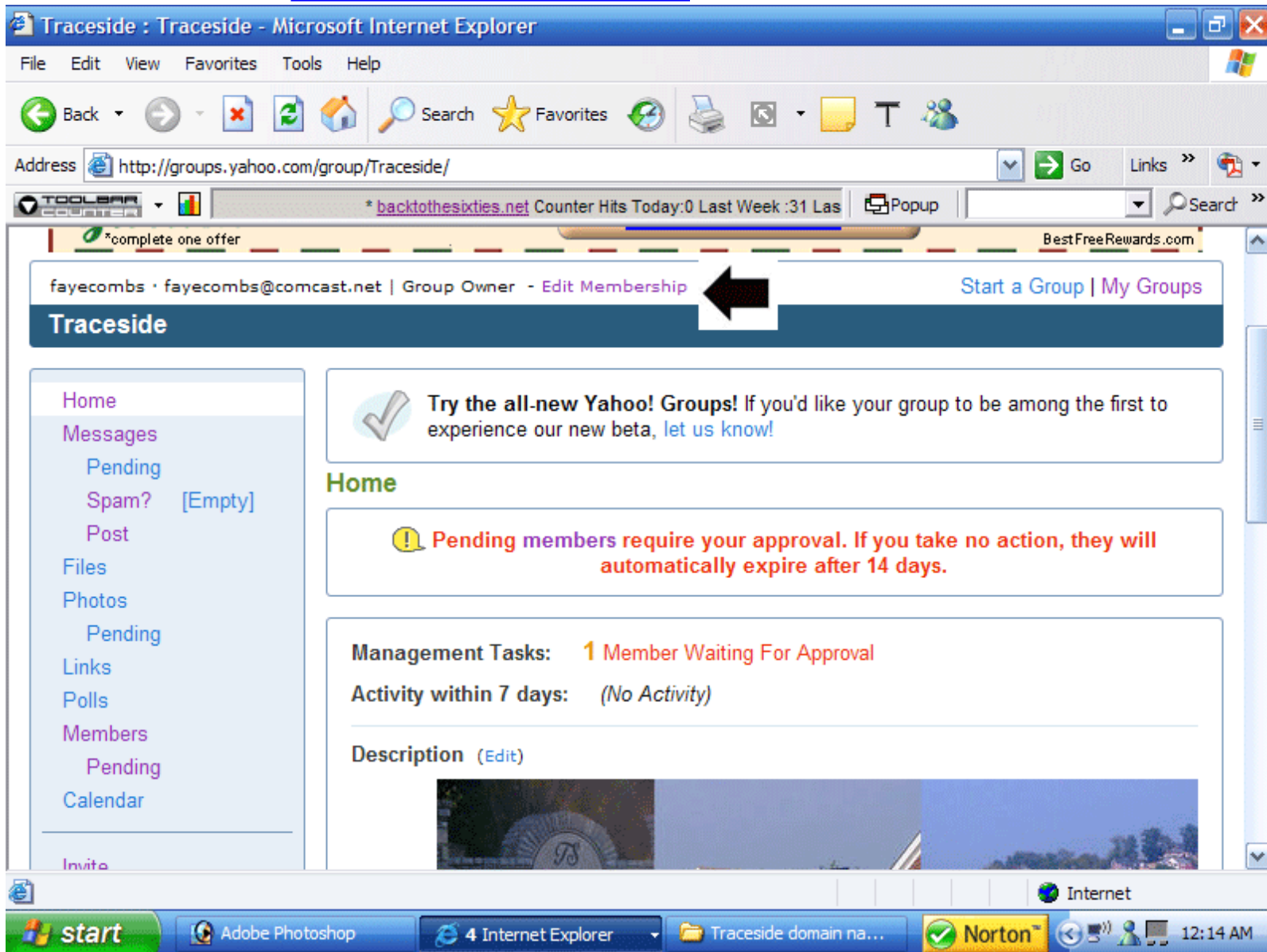


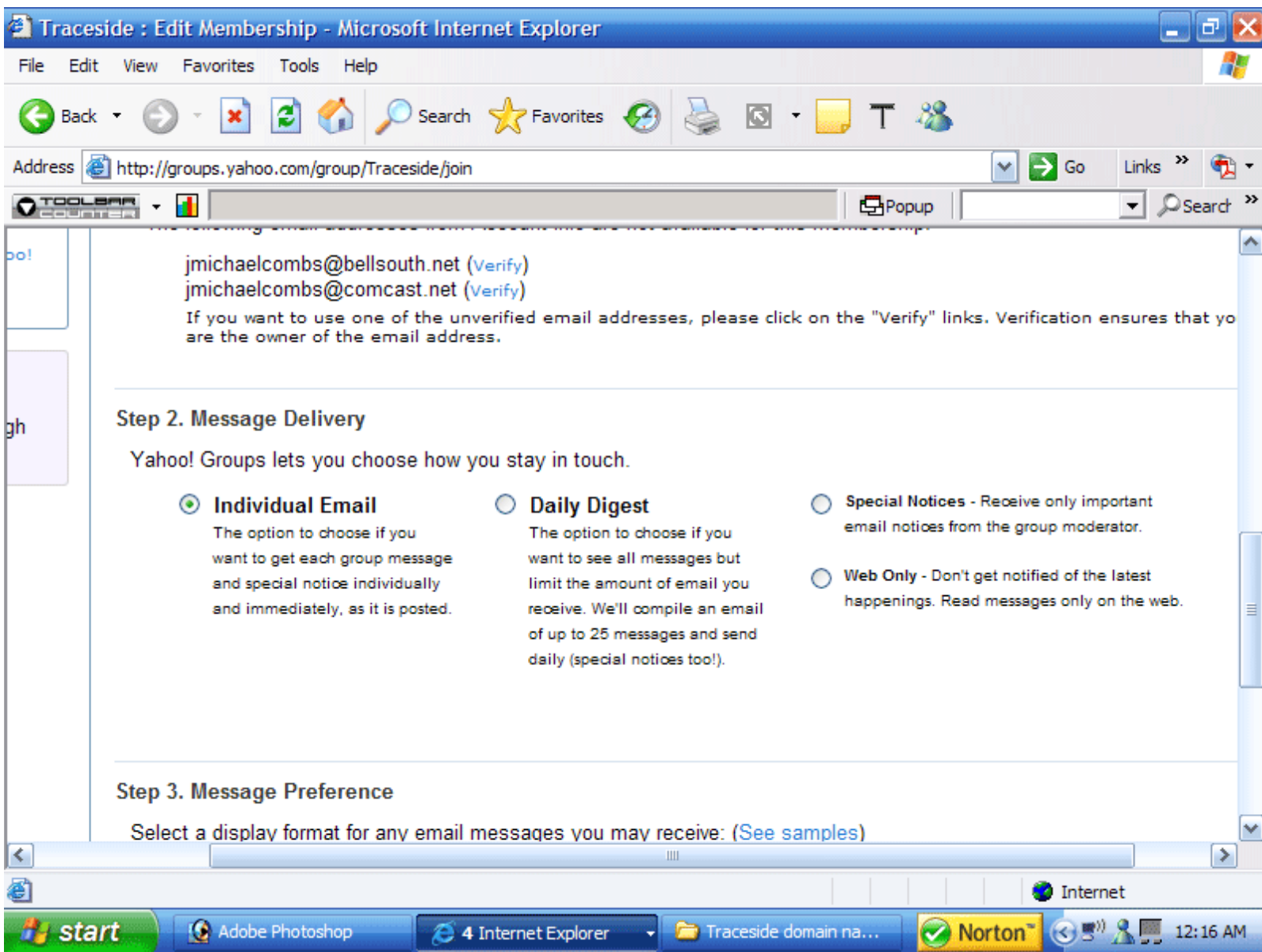
Choosing Options for Receiving Yahoo Email

Directions including screen shots showing how to choose options other than receiving individual emails on the Traceside Yahoo email group. First, access the site at <http://groups.yahoo.com/group/Traceside/> When you access the site, the page will look like this:



The arrow is pointing to the words **Edit Membership**. In order to choose different options for receiving or not receiving emails from the group, you must click on **Edit Membership**.

Once you click on **Edit Membership**, you will be taken to a page where you will scroll about halfway down the page and will see the screen as it appears on the following page:

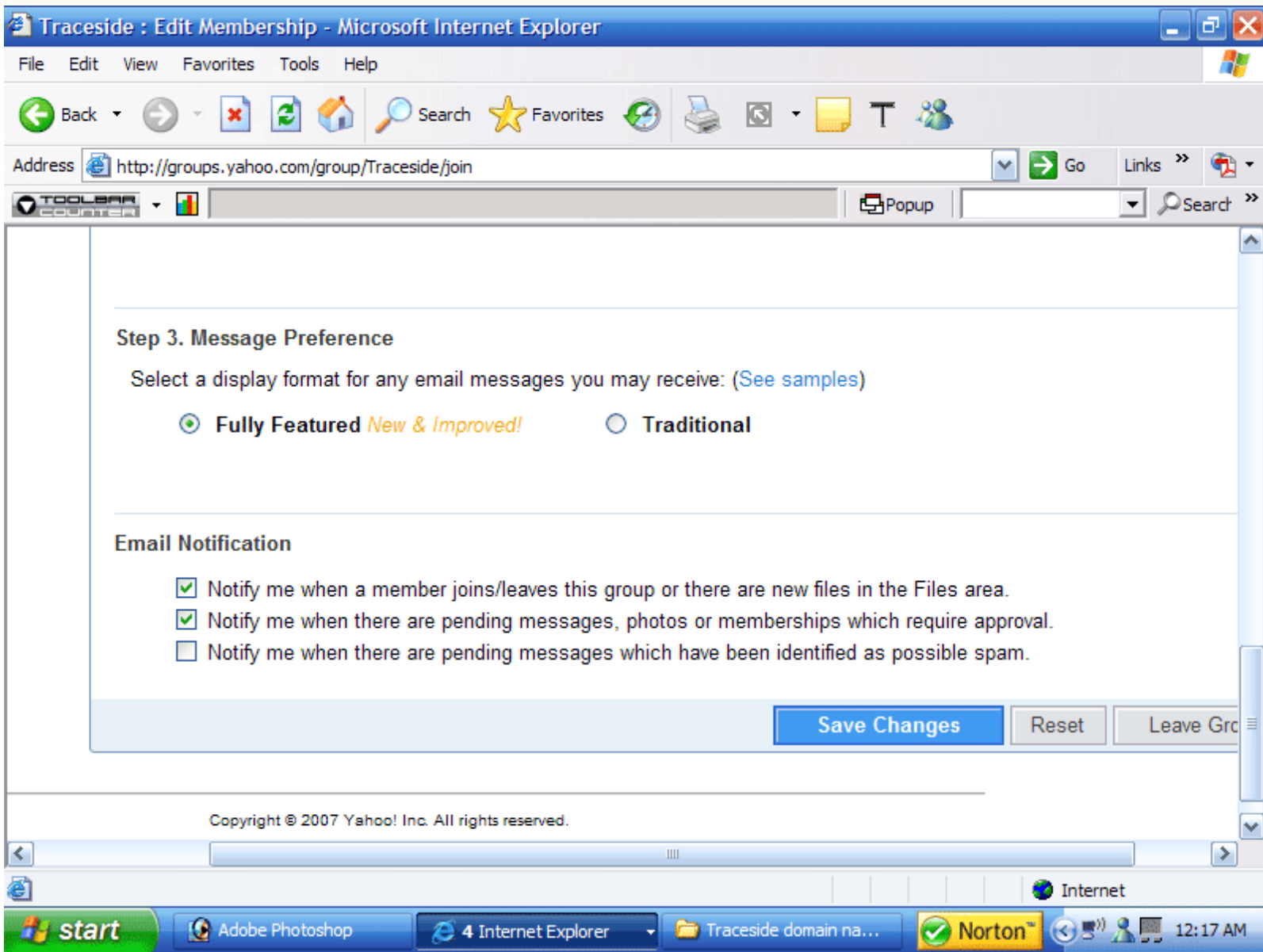


Note that there are are four options. The first is to receive Individual Emails as they are sent. This is what many people are objecting to.

If you want to receive the emails, but just not that many, you can choose the second option which is Daily Digest. You will receive one email digest daily with any and all emails sent that day thru the group.

The third option you will find to the far right says Special Notices. This indicates that you only want to receive emails that are marked by the sender as Special Notices. The big problem with this option is that very few people think to mark the emails as special notices, and most people don't realize that there might be people out there who have marked that option.

The fourth option is Web Only. What this option will do is stop all emails from coming to you, but you still remain a member of the group and can access the site at any time and review the messages at your leisure. Once you make your selection, you will then scroll to the bottom of the page, and you will see the screen as it appears on the next page:



If you are finished choosing your delivery option for your Traceside Yahoo email, then you are ready to click on the blue button that says Save Changes. Click on it, and you will be all set.

That's it - that's all there is to it. There's no need to unsubscribe if you are annoyed by excessive emails. If you follow these simple steps, you should have no problems
